1. INTRODUCTION

Government of India, Ministry of Human Resource Development (Department of Technical Education) New Delhi, reserves seats (for each State.) in Engineering in Degree and Diploma level Institutions approved by AICTE, in other States, The allocation of seats is generally reviewed every two years.

The seats so reserved are placed at the disposal of Govt. of Goa and the nomination of the candidate shall be done by the Director of Technical Education, through Centralised Admission Committee on the basis of merit, determined as per the provisions of this Prospectus.

Details of seats allotted to the State of Goa by Deputy Educational Advisor (NIT), MHRD New Delhi, for Degree and for Diploma courses in other States, are available in this Prospectus.

Note: As per MOU between ICAR, Directorate of Agriculture , Govt. of Goa and Konkan Krishi Vidhyapith, Dapoli, one seat in B. Tech. (Agriculture Engg) is reserved for Goan students. The eligibility and merit criteria for this seat will be as per the directives of the Directorate of Agriculture, Krishi Bhavan, Tonca, Caranzalem.

NOTE: Allotment of seats indicated in above table is as per seats allotted by MHRD for the year 2009-2010, for nomination by State of Goa. In case the above seat allotment list is revised by MHRD for the year 2010-11, revised list would be applicable at the time of admission rounds.

3. INSTRUCTIONS TO THE APPLICANTS

- 3.1 The prescribed application form is supplied along with the prospectus and will be issued to the applicant on payment of Rs. **350/-** in cash at DTE, Porvorim.
- 3.2 The application form must be filled by the applicant in own handwriting, duly signed by him / her.
- 3.3 The application should be submitted by the candidate **in person** at the Admission Centre in the Directorate of Technical Education, Alto-Porvorim, Goa. The members of Admission Committee shall scrutinize the same, before issuing the Acknowledgement Card. Incomplete application form shall not be accepted.
- 3.4 The application form must be accompanied by attested photocopies of relevant certificates and testimonials as per the list attached in the application form. A recent (taken not earlier than 3 months before the date of application) passport size photograph should be affixed to the application form in the space provided. One more copy of the same photograph should be affixed on the admission card.
- 3.5 Any change in the applicant's mailing address should be immediately intimated to the Admission Committee at Directorate of Technical Education, Porvorim.
- 3.6 Applications received after the expiry of the last date shall be summarily rejected. Any correspondence in this regard shall not be entertained. Any request from an applicant for granting extension of time for admission at a later date shall not be entertained under any circumstances.
- 3.7 Candidates shall report **in person** for the rounds of admission at the specified date and time, to the Committee, when called in order of merit list.
- 3.8 Admission shall be strictly on the basis of merit, determined as per the provisions of this Prospectus. The applicant will be offered admission to course of his/her choice, available at the time of his/her turn, on the basis of merit.
- 3.9 Details such as name of the Diploma Institutions, addresses, fees to be paid, hostel facilities etc. are not readily available with Directorate of Technical Education, and shall be provided as and when available.
- 3.10 An applicant offered admission to a Professional course, while collecting the Admission Card, shall pay admission fee of Rs. **700/-** and furnish deposit of **Rs.1000/-**, both by Demand Draft, drawn on any Nationalized bank, in favour of "**Director of Technical Education**" **payable at Panaji**. The deposit shall be refunded to the candidate who secures admission at the Institute where he is nominated, provided such a request is submitted to the Admission Committee within 30 days of issue of Allotment letter. In case the candidate fails to secure

admission or refuses to avail the seat allotted, he/she shall forfeit the deposit. The deposit shall be refunded only if the State or Institute refuses to admit the candidate.

- 3.11 All applicants should report in person to collect “Allotment letter” on due date. The same shall not be handed over to any other person.
- 3.12 Directorate of Technical Education, Government of Goa, is only the nominating agency and the admission shall be given/confirmed by the respective Institution/ Universities only.
- 3.13 While handing over the letter of allotment for GOI seats, the admission already granted in local professional course if any, shall be kept in suspension. In case of non-confirmation of allotted GOI seat, the candidate must inform the office of the DTE on or before **8th calendar day** from the date of the issue of the Allotment letter, failing which admission in local Professional College or Diploma Institute shall be cancelled and these vacant seats shall be allotted to other candidates in the waiting list. Candidates shall submit an undertaking to this effect.

4. ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION

4.1 Common Eligibility Criteria

The applicant for admission to any of the Degree and Diploma Engineering courses as Govt. of India nominee must satisfy the following criteria.

1. The applicant must be a citizen of India.
2. The applicant must have studied and passed Std. XII examination from Schools/ Colleges in the State of Goa for Degree courses. The applicant should have passed the Higher Secondary School Certificate (Std. XII) examination of the Goa Board of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education, or its equivalent examination with English, Physics and Mathematics and one of the subjects of Chemistry/ Bio- Technology/ Computer Science/Biology as compulsory subjects and secured not less than 50% aggregate marks (i.e. 150/300) in the subjects of Physics, Mathematics and one of the subjects of Chemistry/ Bio- Technology/ Computer Science/Biology obtained in one and the same sitting.
3. For Diploma courses the applicant must have studied and passed Std Xth (SSC) examination from schools in the State of Goa in one and the same sitting with English, Mathematics and Science as compulsory subjects.
4. The applicant must also satisfy the academic eligibility criteria of the State where candidate is intending to seek admission.
5. For Degree courses, the applicant must have appeared for Goa Common Entrance Test 2010 (GCET-10) in relevant subjects.

Note: Applicants have to fulfil eligibility criteria prescribed by the nominating State viz Goa as well as the State where admission is sought.

4.1.1 State wise eligibility for Degree seats

The Govt. of India seats in Engineering/Technology, allotted to Govt. of Goa are distributed over the four States of Maharashtra, Karnataka, Gujarat and Tamil Nadu. As such the students seeking admission against GOI seats for Degree courses have to satisfy the academic eligibility conditions of the respective State. As per information currently available in this Directorate, the academic eligibility criteria specified in these States is as follows: -

(1) Maharashtra State: -

Applicant should have passed Std. XII of the Maharashtra State Board of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education, Pune or its equivalent examination with subjects English, Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics and secured 50% marks in the subject of Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics added together.

(2) Karnataka State: -

The applicant should have passed Std. XII or equivalent examination with Physics and Mathematics alongwith Chemistry/Bio-technology/Computer Science/Electronics /Biology as optional subjects, with English as one of the language of study and obtained a minimum of 45% marks in aggregate in Physics, Maths alongwith the optional subject.

(3) Gujarat State: -

Candidates should have passed the qualifying examination (Std. XII) of the Gujarat State Board of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education or its equivalent examination with English, Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics.

(4) Tamil Nadu State (Annamalai University): -

Candidates should have passed the qualifying examination (Std. XII) or its equivalent examination with Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics as compulsory subjects.

(5) B.Tech (Agriculture Engg.):-

Candidates should have passed the qualifying examination (Std. XII) or its equivalent examination with Physics, Chemistry, Maths, Biology and English. The candidate should have 10 years residence in the State of Goa & must have appeared for GCET – 2010.

4.1.2 State wise eligibility for Diploma seats:-

Candidates nominated against the Govt. of India seats by Directorate of Technical Education, shall have to satisfy the eligibility conditions mentioned above and he/she should have secured 50% marks in aggregate in the qualifying examination (Std. X) and in addition, fulfill conditions prescribed by the respective States.

5. ADMISSION PROCESS

5.1 Guidelines for selection (Degree/Diploma)

1. There shall be no reservation for any category unless indicated by the allotting agency viz. MHRD, Govt. of India. All the candidates shall be considered in General Category only. All seats shall first be offered to applicants fulfilling residence requirements as applicable to candidates seeking admission under General Category to First Year of Professional Degree/Diploma Courses in the State of Goa, followed by other eligible applicants.

The eligibility requirements under General Category are as follows:

An applicant belonging to General Category must have studied and passed Std. XIIth or equivalent examination from schools/colleges in the State of Goa and must have resided in Goa continuously for a minimum **period of 10 years** (5 years for those whose either of the parents/ grandparents is born in Goa), immediately preceding the last date/month of application OR Be son/daughter of Government of Goa deputationists or employees posted outside Goa and must have passed the qualifying examination from Central Board of Secondary Education, New Delhi or other recognised State Boards.

An applicant who is found eligible according to the above criterion in a particular year shall continue to be considered as eligible for the subsequent 3 years.

Relaxations in Residential Requirements for General Category:

- a) Any period spent by the applicant outside Goa on account of posting / leave/ training / deputation of either of his / her parents being the Goa State Government Employee shall be counted towards the continuous residence of 10 years (5 years for those whose either of the parents/grand parents is born in Goa).
- b) Any period spent by the applicant in another State, under the scheme of Exchange Programme as the student of Navodaya Vidyalaya from Goa, shall be counted towards the ten years continuous residence in Goa (5 years for those whose either of the parents/grand parents is born in Goa).
- c) An applicant born in Goa and has studied and passed qualifying examination (Std. XIIth) from schools/colleges in the State of Goa, should have minimum residence of overall 10 years (5 years for those whose either of the parents/grand parents is born in Goa) in the State of Goa, as on last date of submission of application for admission.

-
2. The candidates shall be offered the seats available in order of merit. A candidate who is offered a seat once shall not be considered in the list again unless he is refused admission by the state/institute.
 3. For admissions to Degree seats, the academic eligibility shall be based on the marks obtained in the qualifying examination (i.e. HSSC) only. However, merit list shall be based on the performance of the candidates in GCET- 10.

The basis for preparing the Merit list for admissions to different courses shall be as follows, based on the marks scored in Goa Common Entrance Test – 2010.

- a. The merit list shall be based on aggregate marks of GCET-2010 in the subjects of **Physics and Mathematics**.
- b. In case the above marks of two or more applicants are equal, applicant with more marks in **Mathematics** shall be placed higher in the merit list.
- c. In case the marks in Mathematics are also equal, applicant with more marks in **Chemistry** will be placed higher in the merit list.
- d. In case the marks in Chemistry are also equal, applicant with more marks in **Biology/Computer Science** will be placed higher in the merit list.
- e. If all the above are also equal, then the applicant with earlier date of birth will be placed higher in the order of merit.

4. For admissions to Diploma seats, the merit list of Diploma courses shall be based on the total qualifying marks, at Std X (SSC) which includes additional marks if any, as under:

a. Applicants who have represented the country in a recognised sport or game at an International event, at least once during the period of Std.IX and Std X only.	15 marks
b. Applicants who have represented the state of Goa in a recognised sport or game at a National Event, at least once during the period of Std.IX and Std X only.	10 marks
c. Applicants who have passed the NCC Examination ('B' or 'C' Certificate) during Std.IX and Std. X only.	5 marks
d. Applicant who has been awarded Best N.C.C. Cadet in India	15 marks
e. Applicants who have represented the State of Goa as N.C.C Cadets at the Republic Day Parade in New Delhi during the academic year of Std.IX and Std X only.	10 marks
f. Applicants who received National Bravery Award	10 marks
g. Applicants who received State Bravery Award	5 marks

However, the total marks added to any one applicant on account of (a),(b),(c),(d),(e), (f) & (g) above shall not exceed 15 (fifteen) marks.

The basis for preparing the merit list for admissions to different courses will be as under:

Stage 1: In the first instance, Merit list will be made in descending order of aggregate qualifying marks obtained by the applicants in **SSC**.

Stage 2: In the event that two or more applicants obtain same aggregate marks in Stage 1 above, then, inter-se Merit will be determined by aggregate marks obtained by such applicants in the subject **Mathematics**.

Stage 3: In the event that two or more applicants obtain same aggregate marks in Stage 2 above, then, inter-se Merit will be determined by aggregate marks obtained by such applicants in the subject of **Science**.

Stage 4: In the event that two or more applicants obtain same aggregate marks in Stage 3 above, then, inter-se Merit will be determined by aggregate marks obtained by such applicants in the subject of **English**.

Eligibility criteria and Determination of merit for applicants with grades at qualifying examination

In case of applicants passing qualifying examination from CBSE/other recognized Boards, where grades are awarded and corresponding absolute marks are not available, Cumulative Grade Point Average would be considered for determining eligibility. For Engineering Courses, candidates need to obtain minimum CGPA of 6.0 in case of General Category, and 5.0 in case of SC/ST/OBC category, in one and same sitting. In case of Garment Technology course, applicants from General Category need to secure minimum CGPA of 5.0 and SC/ST/OBC candidates 4.0, in one and same sitting.

To determine merit list ranking the grades obtained by such applicants in individual subjects would be converted into equivalent marks.

Following table would be used to determine CGPA and equivalent marks: (for CBSE applicants)

Note: In case of applicants where grades are awarded at qualifying examination and no individual aggregate marks are available, the method as specified in the Common Prospectus issued for admission to Diploma Courses in the State of Goa, for the Year 2010-11 would be applicable to such cases.

5.2 Other Rules

1. Candidates shall be offered the seats available in order of merit. A candidate, who is offered and accepts a seat once, shall not be considered in the list again, unless he is refused admission by the State/Institute, where he/she has been allotted a seat.
2. In case candidate/s refuse to accept available seat/s during admission round, he/she shall be considered in subsequent rounds.
3. The candidate shall have to deposit Rs. 1000/- immediately to confirm the allotment of seat to him/her, failing which the seat shall be offered to the next candidate on the list.
4. DTE, Goa or Admission Committee shall not be responsible for allotment or change in allotment of institution, by the other State/s.
5. The seat allotted to the candidate under Centralised Admission in any Professional course in Goa, if any, shall be temporarily suspended for 7 (SEVEN) days from the date of allotment of the GOI seat. If the candidate does not report to the Admission Committee, that he has joined the Institution allotted under GOI nomination within 7 days, the seat allotted to him/her in Professional course in Goa shall be cancelled on 8th Calendar day and allotted to the next candidate in the merit list.
6. In case candidate does not find the seat/Institute/State allotted to him convenient and intends to cancel the GOI seat allotted, he/she should report within seven days to the Admission Committee. In such cases (reported within seven calendar days), 50% of the deposit of Rs. 1000/- shall be returned to the candidate, and the candidate shall not be considered for admission in the remaining rounds of admission.
7. In case candidate neither avails the allotment, nor informs the Committee about non-availing within seven days, the entire amount of admission fee and deposit shall be forfeited. Such candidates shall not be considered for admission in the remaining rounds of GOI admission and any seat allotted to them in any Professional course in Goa may be cancelled.

6. DETAILS OF FEES AND REFUNDS

Details of fees charged for various Courses will be as per rules and regulations of the respective States/Institutions, where the candidate is seeking admission. An applicant who is offered admission to a Professional course, shall pay admission fees of Rs.700/- through a separate Bank Draft drawn on any Nationalized bank, in favour of “Director of Technical Education” payable at Panaji, and while collecting the allotment letter, shall deposit an amount of Rs. 1000/- by Demand Draft, drawn on any Nationalized bank, in favour of “Director of Technical Education” payable at Panaji. The deposit shall be returned after the candidate secures admission at the Institute where he is nominated. This deposit is to ensure the seriousness among the candidates seeking admission to GOI seats.

Note: Details of various fees charged by States/Institution availability any standard of hostel and other infrastructure facility are not readily available in this Directorate and candidates are advised to ascertain the same from respective State/Institutions.

6.1 Cancellation of Admission and Refund of Deposit

The students who secured admission against allotted GOI seats shall be eligible for refund of deposit, provided the request is submitted within one month from the date of issue of allotment letter. No claim shall be entertained after one month.

The Cancellation of admission and refund of fees, if any, from the Institutes in other States shall be governed by the rules and regulations of the respective Institution /State/University.
